The Greater Flint Health Coalition Access Committee created this Health Care Resource Guide to help you find the health care services you need for yourself and your family.

The agencies listed in this guide have worked together to help you locate not only basic health care services, but also specialist services when they are needed. These clinics will do their best to provide you with affordable care and keep your health and medical needs met.

Each of these providers or clinics offers a variety of services. At many locations, you must have an appointment, so call first to find out if you need an appointment and what you need to bring, such as picture ID or proof of income. Fees for services at many of the clinics are based on income and may be reduced or free if you live on a limited income and meet certain state and federal guidelines.

This guide lists clinics by location to help you find care as close to home as possible. It also lists the services you might need, such as adult care, vision care, obstetrics, child health, prescription assistance and more.

Hamilton Community Health Network

Hamilton provides healthcare services to all community residents, regardless of insurance or ability to pay. Services include adult medicine, OB/GYN, dentistry, pediatric, behavioral health, podiatry, case management, prescription/pharmacy assistance, and referrals for specialty care.

COVERAGE

Medicaid

Medicaid is comprehensive health care coverage administered by the State of Michigan to provide health care services to low income individuals.

ELIGIBILITY

Families that receive cash assistance from the Family Independence Program are automatically eligible. Other families must apply at local Department of Human Services locations. Income and asset level are used to determine eligibility. Levels range from 38% of the Federal Poverty Level for single non-workers to 185% of the Federal Poverty Level for children ages 0-3. These guidelines are based on your income level and family size and they determine your eligibility for specific services and coverage programs highlighted throughout the Healthcare Resource Guide.

The FPL is determined based on income and family/household size. For example, if you are in a household with 4 people and the combined income of all household members is \$22,350, you would be at 100% of the FPI
