

Flint Health Care Coverage Talking Points

Eligibility Criteria:

- As a result of a waiver granted by the Federal government, many residents who are currently not covered by a Healthy Michigan Plan, MiChild, or Medicaid are now eligible for additional health care coverage if they meet the following requirements:
 - Consumed water from the Flint water system and lived, worked or received child care or education at an address that was served by the Flint water system at any time from April 2014 and a future date
 - AND are
 - Under the age of 21 or are a pregnant woman
 - AND
 - Meet the following income requirements:

Expanded Services:

- Doctor visits, including well child visits, physicals, routine check-ups and shots
- Dental visits
- Vision care
- Nutrition counseling
- Behavioral health services
- “Family Supports Coordination” services or wrap-around services:
 - Case managers (licensed nurses or licensed social workers) are assigned to families to link them to comprehensive services and make a plan for the family’s needs to ensure that residents get access to all the services they need to live healthy lives. These services include educational resources, nutritional support and mental health services.

Frequently Asked Questions:

- Do I have to pay any out of pocket costs for these benefits?
 - No. If you qualify for these additional services, you will not be required to pay premiums, contributions, or co-pays.

- Can I apply if I already have another insurance?
 - Yes. But, if you have another insurance, the other insurance will be used first. And, this insurance may cover things that your other insurance may not cover such as family supports coordination or copayments.
- What if I am already covered by Medicaid?
