

# GET TESTED FOR COVID-19

## FREE TESTING IS AVAILABLE IN FLINT

### WHEN TO GET TESTED

- If you feel sick
- If someone close to you is sick or has symptoms
- Regardless of having symptoms or not, you are encouraged to be tested — especially if you work outside the home.

### TYPES OF COVID-19 TESTS

Tests can be with a nasal or oral swab. At Flint area testing sites, a PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) Test is performed. These tests are the most accurate and use an oral swab.

### HOW TO GET TESTED?

- Please consult with your healthcare provider or one of the testing sites listed below. Following up with your healthcare provider is very important after testing.
- The oral swab test requires you to not eat, drink or use tobacco products 30 minutes prior to testing.

### RESULTS

- If you test positive:
  - Stay home except to get medical care
  - Separate yourself from other people in your home
  - Monitor your symptoms
  - Clean all “high touch” surfaces everyday
  - Avoid sharing personal household items
  - Participate in contact tracing calls
